Fertilizer Assessment Funds – Call for FY 2018 Proposals

The Fertilizer Advisory Committee will hold their annual meeting in Bozeman February 21-22, 2017. We will hear progress reports from FY 2017 funded projects, and consider proposals for FY 2018 funding. As a reminder, the intent of these research dollars is "to improve Montana's economy by providing farmers and ranchers the most accurate information possible about fertilizer use and soil management for greatest profits consistent with environmental protections on the many varied soil and climatic conditions of the state."
